

18th Hole – 318m Mens & 283m Ladies – Par 4

The eighteenth hole has seen the undoing of many a fine round. The tee shot requires more than any other dogleg on the course; a well placed landing. The hole swings hard left as the club house comes into view.

A lateral water hazard resides on the left hand side of the fairway as the Gunbower Creek comes back into view.

With a greenside bunker on the left, and gallery of onlookers; any third shot that is not a putt, takes on higher level of importance, as close scrutiny from the gallery is sure to follow.
